#### Faith Life

This term, our Faith Life unit will be focussed on healthy minds and healthy bodies and will be titled, "If you're happy and you know it!" We will investigate how the food we eat affects our brain, the importance of exercise and how we can create a healthy mindset and how our emotions affect our wellbeing. This will link directly with our Bike Education and

### **Numeracy**

Some of the topics we will be covering this term are:

Number and Algebra

Multiplication and Division (the relationship between the two operations)

Mental Maths & number facts

Measurement and Geometry

2D shapes and 3D objects

Angles

Statistics and Probability

Data representation and interpretation



Maths Mate will be continued weekly for homework along with a StudyLadder pod focussing on each topic we are learning about in class.

## Literacy

#### Reading

Our reading lessons this term will continue to focus on Stars and Cars Comprehension strategies with shared reading texts and activities linked to topics included in our Faith Life unit and Bike Education.

We will continue to focus on reading with expression and understanding new words in what we read.

#### Writing

We will begin with a poetry unit with a focus on ANZAC Day readings to create our own poems. We will also complete some journalling including food diaries and camp. There will be emphasis placed on handwriting in preparation for the students to receive their pen licences in Term 3.

### Spelling & Phonics

We will be investigating:

- spelling rules
- different syllable types
- revising when and where to use apostrophes

Spelling words will continue for homework and the students will complete a partner test every fortnight. The activities for spelling can be chosen from the spelling grid in the Homework folder in Google Drive.

Please continue to encourage your child to read independently, aloud or listening to reading daily.
